## Activity – Sorting colours.

#### Key areas of learning:

- Maths Matching / Sorting / Size Recognition
- Fine Motor Skills

#### What you will need:

- Different coloured objects around the house (pens, utensils, toys etc)
- Different coloured paper matching the colours of objects you have found. (you could paint the paper with your child if you don't have coloured paper)


#### Keywords:

Red, Yellow, Blue, Green, Orange, Brown

#### What to do:

- Go on a hunt around the house for different coloured objects.
- Put all objects that you have found into a pile. Ask your child to start sorting onto the coloured paper. You may need to model the activity to your child so they have a better understanding.
- Once all items have been sorted you could count how many objects you have of each colour.





## Activity – Shape faces

#### Key areas of learning:

- Maths Shape recognition/ exploring shapes
- Creativity

#### What you will need:

- Templates of different shapes and sizes
- Mirror
- Glue
- Scissors
- Paper

#### **Preparation:**

• Draw and cut out different shapes. If your child is able to they can cut the shapes out with support from you.


#### Keywords:

• Triangle, circle, square, rectangle, star, heart.

#### What to do:

- Look in the mirror with your child. Talk about what you can see? Eyes, mouth, nose etc. What shape do you think your eyes are? Use the shapes already cut for them to choose which shape they think their eyes may look like.
- Encourage your child to stick the shapes on to the paper to create a selfportrait of themselves.
- Talk about the shapes they have used and question if they can find a certain shape.





## Activity – Matching Shapes

#### Key areas of learning:

- Shape recognition
- Matching
- Turn taking

#### What you will need:

- 2 trays (baking trays if appropriate)
- Pen
- Paper
- Different sensory media, i.e. rice, lentils, oats, foam, gel etc.

#### Keywords:

Shapes used, big, small

#### What to do:


- Draw different big and small shapes on a piece of paper then cut out (or use template attached)
- Place some of the shapes into 1 tray
- Fill the other tray with sensory media and mix in the other drawings of shapes
- Encourage child to explore the sensory media and match the same shapes on the other tray

#### Keywords:


#### Ducks, Currant buns, how many, quack, splat, ready steady go!




