Henry Matisse - Abstract collage



1. Cut your coloured paper into different pieces. (If you don't have coloured paper, you can use colouring pencils/pens to colour in plain paper or make patterns).



- 2. Choose paper to stick onto your plain paper, glue the back and stick it where you want.
- 3. Repeat until you are happy with your design.

Extension ideas:

- -The original Henri Matisse collage is called 'The Snail'. Can you use your collage paper to form an animal/object?
- Cut out your collage paper into different shapes. How could you put these together to make a picture?
- What could you use other than paper to make your collage? Explore your house, garden or local park for ideas.
