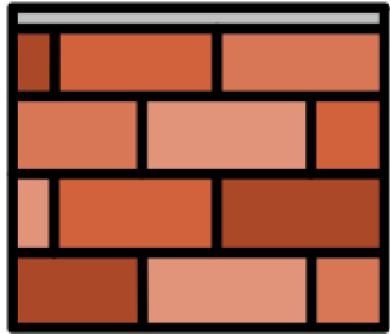
1. This activity can just be done with water; you can use paint or food colouring if you have it available.

Resources you may need

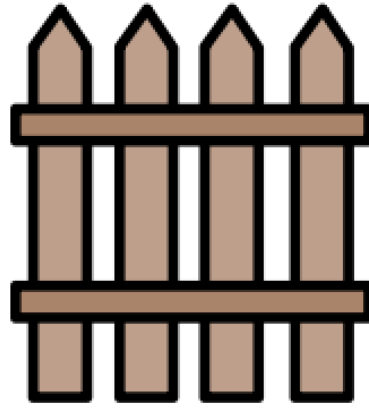
- Fence/ wall/ paved area

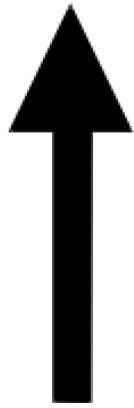

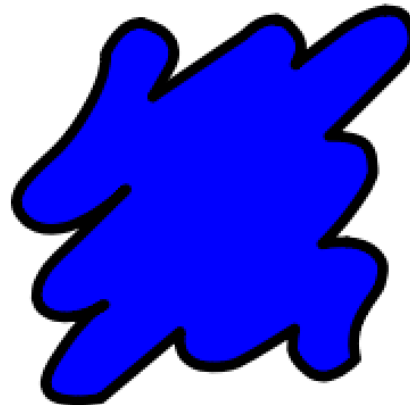
