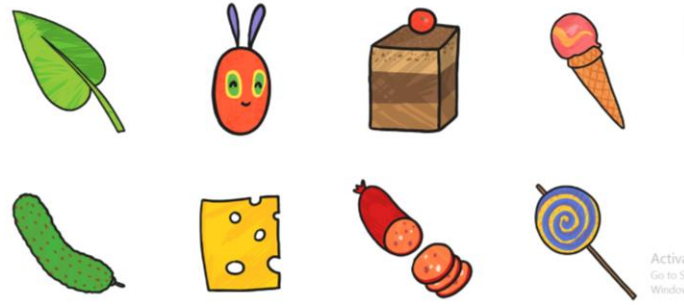


## The Very Hungry Caterpillar Sensory Bin



### The Very Hungry Caterpillar Story Stones

Simply cut out the images and stick them onto a pebble or stone using a liquid glue such as mod podge or PVA. Start by putting a blob of glue onto the pebble, then place the image onto it. Then gently use your fingers to smooth out any air bubbles. Once dry, finish off by spreading some more glue gently over the entire pebble, to create a good seal.

1. Set out a tray using black beans for the base soil, stick stone image cut-outs on pebbles if the plastic food is not available.
2. Read The Very Hungry Caterpillar book with children, children to explore the caterpillar and the food items as reading.
3. Encourage children to feel the black bean soil.

### Extension

- Sequence the food in the order The Very Hungry Caterpillar ate them.
- Order the days of the week.
- Children to sort food into healthy and not healthy food.
