- You could go on a texture hunt at the park and find different textured surfaces to make rubbings.

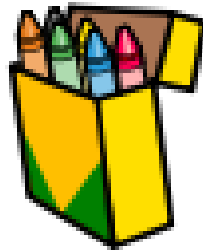




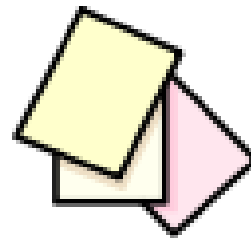
