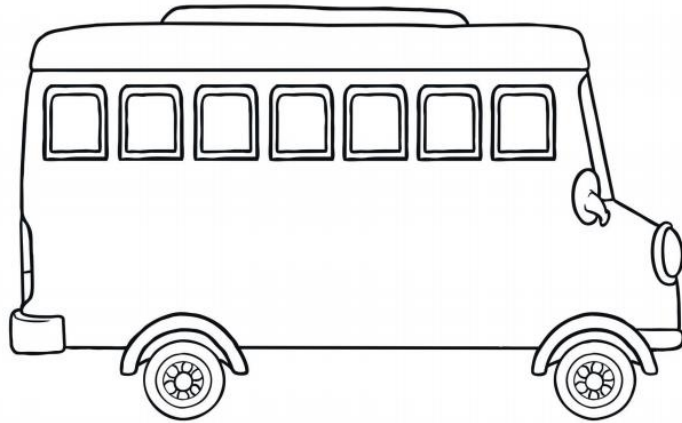


Art - Class bus

Sort people on the bus – girls/boys or adults/children

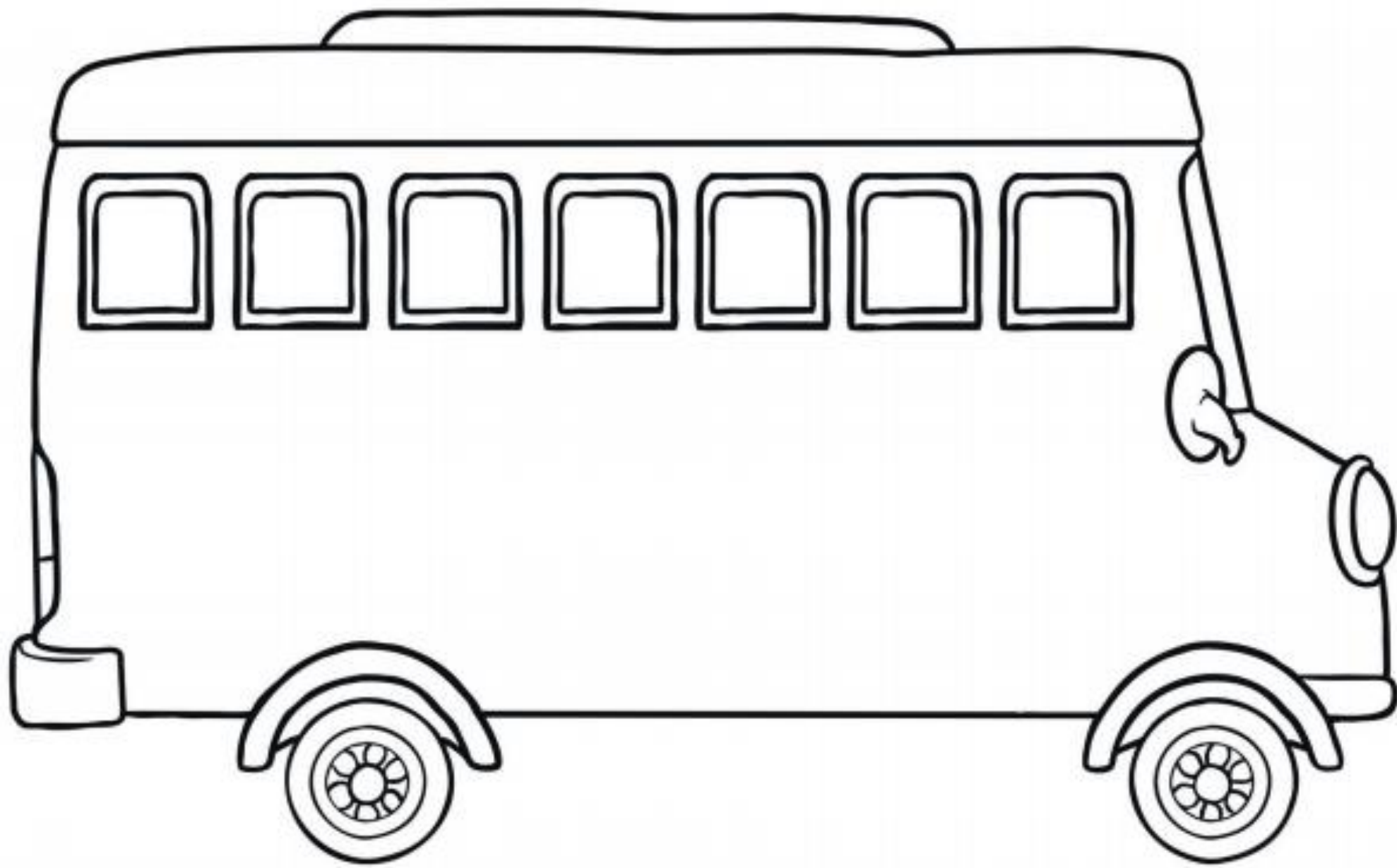
Examples of areas of learning this activity can target:

I can respond to a 'who' question in an immediate situation e.g. "Who is going on the bus next?" **(Communication RG6.12)**

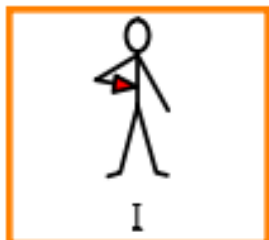
